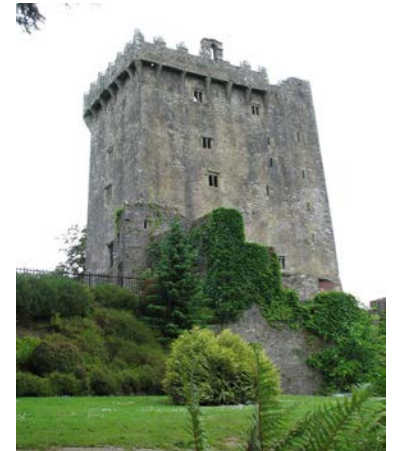

Sunday, October 1: Depart Salt Lake City for Dublin, Ireland.

Monday, October 2: Arrive Dublin airport meet your tour escort, travel south to Dublin city centre for check-in at your hotel. Wednesday, October 4: Leave Dublin heading southwest through race horse country in County Kildare, visit the famous "Rock of Cashel" seat of the Kings of Ireland over a thousand years ago. Continue to Cork and the well known village of Blarney where you will have free time to visit the ruins of Blarney Castle and maybe kiss the stone of eloquence and shop in the ever popular woollen mills, before setting out to Killarney for overnight. Thursday, October 5: Special day tour on the majestic Dingle Peninsula jutting into the rugged Atlantic. This is a journey back to earlier times in Ireland which will show you the way people lived almost three thousand years ago. It has been the setting for numerous movies. You will enjoy free time in the old fishing village of Dingle before returning to Killarney for overnight. (B)

Friday, October 6: We have a visit to Ross Castle, built in the late 15th Century it is set on a rocky outcrop on the shore of Lough Leane (lake). It is an imposing structure and has an interesting 500 year history. Then across the Shannon River and to the Cliffs of Moher. Scenes from the Princess Bride (cliffs of insanity) were filmed here. They are spectacular! Then to the beautiful five star Dromoland Castle, this is a wonderful place to end that special visit to Ireland. End this day in what can only be described as a fairytale setting. (B)

Saturday, October 7: Wake up in one of the most beautiful settings in the world.
